Basic Information

Date: Typically the 2nd Sat. of August thru 1pm the following Monday

Where: Seabeck Christian Conference Center - located west of Silverdale Washington on the Hood Canal. It can be reached taking the Newberry Hill exit from State Highway 3. Go west (uphill) until it ends at Seabeck Hwy. Go right, down the hill, along water until you reach Seabeck. The Center is located on the left across from the marina behind a lagoon.

Check-in: From 3:45 PM to 4:15 PM on Saturday. Meeting location and more details will be sent out prior to event.

Transportation: Transportation is your responsibility. Outbound Students residing in Canada will need to be in Victoria in time to catch the Black Ball Ferry (MV Coho) departing for Port Angeles at 10:30 AM on Saturday (be there 60 minutes early). Contact Becky or Stephanie for a list of students attending so you can arrange car-pooling options.

Bring a PASSPORT in order to enter US immigration.

Students residing in the US will need to travel to Seabeck to arrive at 3:45PM. DO NOT arrive earlier than this!

Departure: All students will depart Seabeck between 1 and 1:30PM on Monday.

Content: The weekend is a mixture of conversations and activities as we help you address your re-entry into your home society. Individual, small group and large group activities are balanced in order to help you get the most of out of the weekend.

Please Bring:

- Passport
- Casual clothing: jeans, shorts, sweatshirts, athletic shoes
- Bedding will be provided by Seabeck Christian Conference Center
- Personal funds for purchases (Seabeck has a small community store adjacent to the Center)
- Cameras (There will be a group photo session)
- Swim Suit and beach towels
- Flashlight
- Insect Repellent
- Candy or snack from Candy or snack from your host country to share

Meals/Lodging for students: Meals will be provided by the Center. Vegetarian and other dietary meals must be pre-ordered when you confirm your attendance. Seabeck will accommodate you to the extent possible. There will be ample vegetables and fresh fruit.

Students will be housed dormitory style at the center.

Meals/Lodging for Parent: We encourage parents to attend the Saturday afternoon session and dinner. If you choose to come, any housing or meal accommodations are up to you to take care. There are several hotels not far from Seabeck. Staying at Seabeck is not an option.

Cost:

The cost per student (excluding transportation) and the meal for parents will be paid by District 5020.
